<p><b>Requirements</b></p>	<p>The successful candidate will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be a Registered Skate Canada Regional Certified Coach in good standing (must provide a current copy of their dashboard);</li> <li>• Have a thorough knowledge of Skate Canada Star 1-5 and CanSkate programs;</li> <li>• Have a solid foundation in teaching basic skating skills with a free skate background preferred.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Roles &amp; Responsibilities</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As a Calalta regional coach, will accept Star 1-4 skaters for private lessons and then once the skater moves to Star 5 or Pre-Juvenile, will transfer that skater to our Nationally trained and/or Nationally certified coaches;</li> <li>• Must be able to partner successfully with National coaches in the transition of skater;</li> <li>• This is a 'feeder' system for the coaches at the National Trained and/or National certified level;</li> <li>• Must be available as a primary coach with a focus on Star 1-4 skaters and take skaters to competitions;</li> <li>• This role is based out of Jimmie Condon arena.</li> </ul>
