2018-2019 Skate Canada: Alberta/NWT/Nunavut Sectional Championships

Sectionals start on Halloween in Red Deer! Great opportunity to check out the new Canada Games Centre!

A few interesting facts:

- 265 skaters from across the Section (AB/NWT/NUN) have qualified for Sectionals

 - 59 or 22% of those are registered under the Calalta name

 - Of those 59, 31 or 53 % are made up of singles, 22 (11 teams) or 37% are Ice Dance and 6 (3 teams) or 10% are Pairs

- Of the 265 registered, 77% of those are single skaters, 15% are Ice Dance and 8% are Pairs

 - Men make up 22% of all skaters registered

- Of the 59 skaters registered under the Calalta name, 4 are dual-discipline skaters – that means singles and either pairs or ice dance! Now that's a commitment!
