

Try Out Policy

Calalta fully supports skaters trying out for both our Pairs and Ice Dance programs. The try out period will be limited to a duration of one week and will include discipline appropriate on-ice and off ice sessions. The sessions will be at no cost to the skater for the one week period.

Prior to skating on Calalta ice or attending off ice sessions as a guest skater, the Pairs and/or the Ice Dance coaches will have received approval in writing from the Director of Skating and the President.

All skaters must be registered with Skate Canada PRIOR to getting on Calalta ice.

Details

- The try out policy applies to one skater either male or female and can be an out-of-club skater or a Calalta skater;
- Choreography, program development or practicing for tests will not be permitted for the duration of the try out (whether it's a Calalta try out skater or an out of club try out skater);
- The try out would be limited to a 1 week period (Mon- Fri) on the appropriate on-ice and off-ice sessions (ice dance or pairs);
- For coaches accompanying the guest skater, both skater and coach will be subject to Skate Canada and Calalta policies and procedures and the coach will be subject to Calalta's Guest Coaching agreement;
- The coaching and lesson arrangement and fees for the skater is independent of Calalta;
- The coaches and skaters must decide within the 1 week period as to their next steps;
- If the duration of the try out will exceed the 1 week period, prior approval must be obtained by the Director of Skating and the President;
- Any billeting arrangements will be independent of the Calalta.

Please ensure the necessary approvals are secured before the try out begins – this includes advising the primary coach that the skater is involved in a try out.
