Triple/Quad Gold Awards

The Alberta Figure Skating Foundation offers skaters the opportunity to apply for their Triple/Quad Gold Awards within 2 years of passing their last gold test. Skaters that are members of the Alberta Figure Skating Foundation by December 31, 2019 are eligible to apply for this award and have the award presented to them at the 2020 Skate Canada: AB-NWT/NUN Banquet held in May. AFSF membership runs from Jan 1 to Dec 31 each year. The individual membership is \$40 and once members skaters are eligible to apply for other grants as well such as the Summer Skating Assistance program.
