Annual General Meeting 7:00 pm Wednesday October 28, 2020 On-line via Zoom

Calalta's Annual General Meeting will be held on-line from 7:00-8:00 pm Wednesday October 28, 2020. As a member you have the opportunity to vote in the Board of Directors, approve the 2020-2021 budget, coaching staff and schedule. The meeting is a great time to bring up any questions you may have regarding the club, Skate Canada or skating in general. A zoom meeting invite will be shared with all members in the next few weeks with all of the necessary details.

Covid-19 Protocol Reminders

Singles skating is a non-cohort sport so we must maintain a 2 meter distance in the stands, changerooms, when you are waiting to get checked in and on the ice. We all have Covid fatigue but Calalta's #1 job is to remain diligent to keep our skaters, coaches, volunteers and staff safe. So that means following all of the protocols set out by Skate Canada, the City of Calgary and the Alberta Government.





What can you do to help us?

- Wear your mask and maintain a 2 m distance;
- At JC leave the Zuca bag in the car wear your shoes inside and carry skates in hand to be put on in the rink;
- As we only have 15 minutes between sessions, we would like you to vacate your seat immediately after the session – this way we can clean your space and then get back to checking everyone in for the next session. Get your shoes on and wipe your blades outside or in the car;
- Guidelines allow one household member to be a spectator at Jimmie Condon this
 person must reside with the skater so we can maintain accurate contact tracing records
 sorry no friends allowed in at this time;
- No spectators at COP. Parents can help tie skates and get their skater on and off the ice but will need to leave as soon as the session starts. We will let you know when COP welcomes parents back.

Volunteer Opportunities

JCA Check in and Cleaning

The cleaning role at Calalta is a high commitment role that will earn you 15 volunteer minutes per session. You would arrive at Jimmie Condon 15 minutes before the session and clean all high touch areas (indicated below). You will be given a log sheet to track your hours. Once your volunteer commitment is fulfilled you will deposit the form in the mailbox at Jimmie Condon indicating your volunteer commitment is complete.

- Disinfecting top of boards
- Disinfecting spectator and skater seats in the viewing area
- Disinfecting high touch areas (Door handles, number pads, music equipment, gates)
- Disinfecting high touch areas in restrooms
- Disinfecting seating area and high tough areas in coaches room
- Disinfecting benches and high touch areas in changeroom
- Windex glass on doors as needed
- Conduct health screen for all participants and spectators
- Take attendance in Uplifter
