

Spring has Sprung FAQs

1) When does the Spring has Sprung event start?

Kicks off Wednesday March 24, 2021

2) How do I order flowers, herbs, tomatoes and strawberries?

It's simple. Go to [Healthy Hunger's website](#), create your registration (add student) add your skater (first and last name), select Alberta, Calgary and Calalta Figure Skating Club and then select your skater's grouping by last name. You can start shopping right from there! If you already use Healthy Hunger with your school, you will need to add in your skater again (there is a + sign to the right of your child's name) and instead of selecting the school, you will select Calalta.

3) I heard about this from a friend and want to order but don't have a skater at Calalta – can I still order?

Of course! Like in #2 above, go to register, and enter your name, select Alberta, Calgary and Calalta and register yourself under the grouping for your last name, pick the May 13 event and start shopping.

4) How do I pay?

Only form of payment accepted is a credit card

5) Why are you using the healthy hunger website and not ordering directly through Ever-Green Greenhouses?

It's easier to use the HH website and all the ordering and payment is taken care of by them – Healthy Hunger is also a local vendor too!

6) I'm worried about the delivery – what are you doing in light of the pandemic?

This is a curbside pickup. You pull into the COP parking lot and your delivery will be placed in your vehicle by a volunteer. Volunteers will be wearing masks and will physical distance.

7) What is the deadline to order on-line?

April 14 is the last day to order.

8) When is the pick-up date?

Pick up has been arranged for Friday May 13 between 3 and 6 pm in the COP parking lot. Stay tuned for exact details of the timing of order pick up.

9) I would like to volunteer – how do I go about doing that?

You can sign up on the [Healthy Hunger website](#) – you will need to register first, add in your skater, click on the event and then click on YES I would like to volunteer. Volunteers will be required to unload the truck, organize the flowers, compile orders and place into vehicles. It will be a 4 hour shift from 2-6 pm on Friday May 13, 2021. Dress accordingly – weather in Calgary can be erratic!

10) Where are the funds going that are being raised from this event?

All profits made will go to the purchase of a rink skating jump harness.

11) Who is running this event?

None other than Cherie Maina – volunteer extraordinaire! She does an amazing job of organizing and making this happen. We will be asking for more volunteers as we get closer to the date.
