Skaters are.....

Prepared

- On time for all off and on ice sessions
- Wearing proper skating attire
- Wearing appropriate footwear in off ice



Respectful

- Skaters are respectful of arena staff and their time
- Bullying will not be tolerated

Enthusiastic

- Come to the rink with a positive attitude
- Support your fellow skaters
- Skaters come to the rink willing to learn



Tidy

- Skaters are responsible for keeping dressing rooms and off ice room clean
- Skaters follow the dressing room assignments

Safe

- Spins are done in the centre of the ice, and jumps on the ends
- Skaters allow "right of way" to those in programs, and lessons

Supportive

- Skaters support their peers, both on and off the ice
- Skaters are role models and younger skaters look up to them

Parents are....

Responsible

- All gates must remain closed
- All equipment must be in good working condition
- Parents are responsible for the behavior of their children



Cooperative

- Parents are respectful of coaches time
- Skaters are not coached by parents from the boards
- Strive to create and maintain cooperative relationships for the purpose of ensuring a positive skating environment
