For skaters, there are countless benefits to an AFSF membership, including discounted rates at AFSF sponsored clinics, access to sponsorships and clinics, summer skating assistance opportunity, discounted fees for the Junior Development Team, access to the Wildrose Competition and Triple/Quadruple Achievement Awards.

Please note: The Membership year runs from January 1st to December 31st of each year.

Please note: To access Triple /Quadruple Gold awards skaters must be members in the year they apply for and receive benefits, as well as the year prior.

Please note: To access summer skating assistance skaters must be members in the year they apply for and receive benefits, **as well as the year prior.** In otherwords, if you are looking for financial assistance for the summer of 2026, you will need to join the <u>AFSF</u> in 2025 before the end of December!

Lock the Dressing Rooms!

Last season we experienced a number of incidents at Jimmie Condon - from the theft of a purse to a stolen vehicle to a few unsavory characters interrupting our sessions. After the media and police got involved, the City responded quickly and hired security. This of course was a short-term solution. The best solution is remove the temptation – keep your stuff locked up or better yet, take it to the boards with you.

The rink staff have provided keys to each dressing room. We have asked skaters and coaches to use these keys and ensure that dressing rooms remain locked when not in use. If a skater arrives late or needs access to the dressing room during a session, they should retrieve the key from the music area, unlock the room, relock it, and return the key to the music area. Furthermore, we have advised our members not to leave any valuables in the dressing rooms and bring their belongings to the boards and keep them within sight.

If an incident occurs or if you feel unsafe, please call 911!

Calgary Police Services have told us to call 911 if we experience any issues. Seriously, bypass the rink staff and go directly to 911. They have also told us AND the rink staff not to engage with anybody at the rink that doesn't belong there – just call 911.



We also encourage concerned parents to call 311 with their concerns. This is an effective way to get the City's attention. Using different methods to escalate concerns helps us advocate for a safer environment for our members.
