First aid kits are available at both Jimmie Condon (JC) and COP rinks:

In the event of an emergency, please contact the rink staff first and they will call 911 on your behalf. The rink staff will ensure emergency personnel are met at the proper doors and brought to your location.

This is a HUGE fundraiser for the club - about \$69K and only happens once every 18-24 months. If we cannot get the full complement of volunteers, the casino CANNOT open AND there is a strong possibility that we lose our next casino.

Books, hobbies, etc may be brought in as there are a number of quiet times during the shift. Notebook computers are allowed with prior permission from the AGLC (great place to get caught up on emails or create that on-line photo book you've never had time to do).

This is a great place for friends, family and spouses to do together...like date night... plus it's warm, meals included and you get a good chunk of your volunteer hours taken care of!!

2019 Apple Fundraiser

Each year our club relies upon holding fundraisers to help offset the costs of our programs. This year, we are offering a new apple fundraising opportunity to help achieve our fundraising goals.

This is no ordinary fundraiser! We have partnered with Davison Orchards, a family farm located in Vernon, BC that specializes in apples. The Davisons offer fresh and high quality fruit and vegetables in a safe and sustainable way. This is a healthy option to support our club.

Our fundraising goal is to sell **1 box per member** of apples from Davison Orchards. Each box contains 15 pounds of apples. Prices range from \$28 to \$35 per box of apples, or \$1.87 to \$2.33 per pound. These apples are freshly picked and delivered straight from the Orchard! There are four choices to select from including Honeycrisp, Ambrosia, Gala and Okanagan Blend (a surprise box of two varieties). When you have finished collecting orders, please transfer the total number of boxes of each variety into the Order Summary Form.



Orders close on October 9, 2019. Please submit your Order Summary Form and monies collected to the office at Jimmie Condon by October 10, 2019 (into the silver mailbox in the lobby). Your apple orders will be ready for you to pickup from Jimmie Condon arena on the morning of Monday, October 21, 2019. Please arrange to pick up your orders on this day.

As an added incentive to help us meet our fundraising goal, the club is offering each member two (2) volunteer hours of credit for every \$100 of Davison apples they sell in this fundraiser. In other words, sell as little as three (3) boxes of Honeycrisp apples and receive two hours of volunteer credit.

You know what they say: "An apple a day". Help everyone get prepared for flu season. Thank you for your support.
