NEW this summer! July and August PTC (Performance Training Center) Training at Winsport – Monday and Wednesday 4-5 pm. This is a cost recovery program and cost is based on the number of athletes participating.

Novice, Junior & Senior Competitive Off Ice Training at the PTC at COP Monday and Wednesday's 4 – 5 pm Maximum of 10 athletes
Cost will be split between skaters
If program sells out the cost will be \$16 per session - \$224.00 for the whole summer

**Open Sessions-**Every Tuesday and Thursday evening from July 4 to August 17, there will be skating from 7:00-8:00 pm on Rose Kohn ice. Open to all skaters and disciplines. Please note as this is an Open session, there will be skaters of all ages and skill level – from little ones to the big skaters who do program run-throughs. **Please manage your expectations** – our goal is to offer a safe session for everyone. This may mean a skater may be required to modify their session and work on skills or a step sequence rather than a full program run-through and ALL skaters may be asked to be mindful of where they are skating and who they are skating with.

# **Music Playing Protocol**

Skaters' music will be played on a "first come, first serve" basis. To ensure that your music will be played, please put your phone in line near the beginning of the session. There will no "holding spots."

Coaches have the right to "bump" into the line as many times during the lesson as appropriate. Obvious misuse of this rule will be addressed ie. Overuse and back-to-back programs will not be allowed when there is a line-up of phones.



Skaters will have the opportunity to have ONE phone in line at a time. They will not be allowed to have both a short and a long in line at the same time. Once their music is done, it can be placed at the end of the line if they so choose.

Skaters attending upcoming competitions will have priority WITHIN REASON. For example, there are several skaters attending Sectionals and each are of equal importance. Once Sectionals is finished, the skaters qualifying for Western Challenge will have priority with Canadian qualifiers and World Team members having priority in December and January. This will be closely watched by the Director of Skating and if skaters are abusing this privilege then it will be removed.
