Sectionals is like provincials in hockey – it is the highest competitive event within the AB|NT|NU Section. Skaters on the Podium Pathway (aka competitive stream) must achieve a certain number of points to skate in this event. Those skaters that do well in Sectionals may qualify for Challenge (semi-finals) which is held in December. For those Junior and Senior skaters that do well in Challenge, may earn a spot in the National Championships which is being held here in Calgary at COP in January.

As parents it can be very hard to know what to say to our children before and after they skate at a competition— we have to be conscious of our words, our tone, our body language, our facial expressions (and probably lots more).

Here are a few words that may assist you:

Believe in yourself. You've prepared diligently, and now its time to show everyone what you're capable of.	You showed incredible courage and determination today. Your commitment is admirable.	
The most important thing is to skate your best have have fun. We're proud of you no matter what happens.	Your performance was fantastic. Remember, every competition is a stepping stone to greater	
	achievements. Keep pushing and reaching for your goals.	



Parents please refrain from providing technical feedback – trust us, your skater knows they didn't fully rotate a jump or didn't get in enough rotations on a spin and their coach is equipped to handle this – that is why you pay them. Your job as a parent to be supportive and encouraging at all times.

Remember, support and encouragement are vital for young athletes. Encouraging words from parents can significantly impact a skater's confidence and mindset before and after their competitions

Missed Ice Policy

If a skater misses an ice session for any reason, the session cannot be made up at another time nor can the amount paid be credited to their account. The skater must skate the sessions they are registered for or pay applicable drop-in fees.

A skater may switch sessions within the same day if the session is not full and the session is the appropriate level for the skater. To do this, an email must be sent to info@calalta.net PRIOR to the switch. It is important to advise your coach as well.

COP Known Ice Cancellations

WinSport Arena is a world class facility that boasts amenities like the Performance Training Centre and Group 23 Sports Medicine Clinic. We feel privileged to utilize this facility for some of our programming. WinSport is host many national and international events. While we may



not always be pleased with the ice cancellations necessary for these events, it is an unavoidable aspect for us. Fortunately, most cancellations at WinSport are planned in advance, and the session fees are adjusted accordingly. In the instances of sudden cancellations, credits are issued to the skaters' accounts, reflecting the original payment amount.
